Vendor Rules and Regulations

Booth rental applications must be submitted during the open house. The open house will take place on May 3rd and May 17th, from 7:00 to 9:00pm. Vendors may choose their location on a first come first serve basis. Payment must be made in full after selecting your location. Vendors will not be given the exclusive rights for the sale of items, goods or services. The price for each booth is \$1,200.00; **this must be paid with cashier's check only and made payable to Homenetmen.**

1. All booths are provided with two tables, two chairs and a sign. Vendors must supply their own additional tables and chairs as necessary.
2. Each vendor will receive 2 festival passes and 1 parking permit.
3. Vehicles are not allowed in the festival area before 8:00am on Thursday June 30th, 2011. The operation of personal vehicles in the festival area is strictly prohibited until the festival is over on July 3rd and the Attendees have departed the campus.
4. All booths must be open everyday during the festival hours of operation. (See Festival dates and hours).
5. Electricity will be provided; vendors must furnish their own extension cords, lights and all other equipment as necessary.
6. It is **prohibited** to share a booth (10 X 10) by two vendors.
7. Vendors are **prohibited** from selling the following items: water guns, party streamers, water bottles for promotional use, items with the Homenetmen logos, and the Navasartian logos. It is also **prohibited** to sell: hookas, cigars, laser pens, electric shockers, fireworks, and toys that are hazardous.
8. Vendors are responsible to transport their own supplies to their designated booth & back.
9. **Vendors will not be given exclusivity.**
10. **It is prohibited to bring food or drinks from outside during festival weekend.**
11. Violators of the above rules and regulations will incur the following fines:
 - A. **First violation \$250.00**
 - B. **Second violation \$500.00**
 - C. **Third violation will result in booth closure**
 - D. **Booth fees are non-refundable**

- ❖ Laser pointers and pens
- ❖ Electric shockers
- ❖ Hazardous toys

Vendors may not share a 10 x 10 booth unless expressed permission is granted by the festival committee.

Furthermore, I accept to adhere to the policies of the Navasartian Games, Festival Committee and the Homenetmen Regional Executive as they are presented to me.
